**Subject : Action Taken Report against complaint of death of cows due to winter and in proper care and maintenance by the owners of dairy farm in the area of Jaitpur, Hari Nagar, Badarpur.**


This is in reference to letter No. 95/20-21/PCA dated 31.12.2021 as subject mentioned above.

In this regard it is submitted that the Veterinary Services Department, Central Zone is taking strict action against stray animals and their owners who lose their animals after milking which roaming on the roads and fend in search of food and poses health and traffic hazard. In this connection the police force had been demanded from the Jaitpur Police Station vide letter No. 1657/DD(VS)/CNZ/2021 dated 30.12.2020 & 1737/DD(VS)/CNZ/2021 dated 28.01.2021 for taking action against stray cattle in the area Jaitpur Hari Nagar & Meethapur. Subsequently on dated 04.01.2021, 13.01.2021, 19.01.2021 02.02.2021 & 12.02.2021 joint action has been taken against stray cattle wherein total 24-stray cattle were impounded and deported to Gausshala after ear tagging at Malviya Nagar cattle pound.

As concerned regarding dead animal the contractor of dead animal is informed immediately that he removed all dead animals from the area of Hari Nagar, Jaitpur & Badarpur.

It is intimated that complainant has property dispute with his relative named Sh. Manish R/o Hari Nagar, Jaitpur and matter is pending before the Hon,ble High Court. The complainant always been informed prior going to action taken by the department but he never reached there. Besides this, he sent the complaint through various routes for putting undue pressure just after the action over.

That it is also pointed out that the area field staff of Veterinary Services Department, Central Zone is keeping a strict watch exercise and upon noticing any illegal activity, necessary action will be taken immediately. And the department will also to impound stray cattle from the area regularly.
