Sub: Request to investigate and take immediate action against the act of gruesome cruelty to the animals -reg.

Sir,

With reference to the above mention subject, it has been brought to the knowledge of the Board through email for Ms. Ritu Herbert stating that the animals at Sanjay Gandhi Animal Care Centre are subject to immense cruelty, the dead cows can be seen lying in the filth and along with other animals. Further she has attached very graphic videos of Sanjay Gandhi Hospital and Shelter wherein a stray dog can be seen eating dead cows and animals do not even have excess to clean water and hygienic food. The copy of complaint along with the videos are enclosed which is self-explanatory.

2. The Cruelty to animals is an cognizable offense under Section 3 and Section 11(1) of the Prevention of Cruelty to animals.

3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court had directed to take action against the erring officials as per the Para 77 of the S.L.P.No.(C) 11686 of 2007, Animal Welfare Board of India Vs A. Nagaraja & Others and the department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension had issued guidelines vide F.No.30/9/2006-Welfare dated 26.5.2006 to take action against such personnel violating the laws. The copies of the same is attached herewith for your information.

4. Therefore, in view of the above, it is requested to investigate into the of gruesome cruelty caused innocent animals and violation of various sections of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act,1960, and take immediate necessary

action against the offenders as per the law. A copy of the action taken report be forwarded to the Board at the earliest.
