Sub : Request to take immediate action in regarding to the complaint related to dog menace in the area of Shanti Layout, Jalahalli West, Bengaluru- Reg

Ref : Grievance Letter No. MOEAF/E/2021/00759 dated 17.05.21 received from Shri Ajay Merchant.

Sir,

With reference to the above cited subject, it is stated that the Board has received a letter by Shri Ajay Merchant from Shanti Layout, Bengaluru stating that his neighbor's tenant has been found to be feeding biscuits to stray animals and then throwing those empty wrappers on the public roads adjoining my residence. The tenants are completely unconcerned with the vaccination and sterilization of these stray dogs. A copy of the email is attached herewith which is self-explanatory.

2. The Animal Birth Control (Dogs) Rules, 2001 notified by the Govt. of India directs the local body to form a monitoring committee which shall be responsible for the planning and management of dog control programme in accordance with the Rules. You are requested to inform us whether the said committee is established and is meeting at least once in every month to assess the progress made in ABC programme as prescribed in the ABC (Dogs) Amendment Rules, 2001 (as amended in 2010). Kindly ensure that the ABC programme is implemented as per the provisions of the above said Rules and the guidelines given in the AWBI module. The same is available in our website: www.awbi.in.

3. It is submitted that the Board vides its guidelines dated 26.02.2015(copy enclosed) for "Pet and street dog and their caregiver" point no.2 of the ubheading "Guidelines for care giver of street dogs" stated that the feeding must not be done in a manner that contributes to littering or dirtying any feeding site and care givers are advised to clean up the feeding site after feeding over.

4. Therefore, in view of the above, it is requested to identifying the feeding spot of the street dogs on the above matter and inspection may please be conducted on priority basis and the inspection reports along with your recommendation be forward to the Board.
