Sub: To take immediate action for repeatedly harassment of compassionate citizens-Reg

Ref: Refer to our letter even number dated 25.08.2015, 28.10.2015 and 14.08.20 on the above subject. (Copy enclosed).

Sir,

With reference to the above cited subject, it is stated that the Board has received a complaint through an email from Shri Maninder Singh from Aparna Prem Society, Shastripuram, Agra stating that he has pet dog who is living with him since the last 6 years. He has been facing constant harassment by the some pet haters. They all says pets should stay indoors and not to seen anywhere in the society. A copy of the email is attached herewith which is self-explanatory.

2. In this regard, it is stated that it is fundamental duty given under Article 51 A(g) of the Constitution of India and it states that *"It shall be duty of every citizen of India to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers and wild life and to have compassion for living creatures."* The removal of dogs from its natural habitat or from the owner is a punishable offense under Section 3, Section 11(1) of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 and Section 428 & 429 of IPC and violation of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. A copy of the complaint letter is attached herewith for your ready reference.

3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court had directed to take action against the erring officials as per the Para 77 of the S.L.P.No.(C) 11686 of 2007, Animal Welfare Board of India Vs A.Nagaraja & Others and the department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension had issued guidelines vide F.No.30/9/2006-Welfare dated 26.5.2006 to take action against such personnel violating the laws. The copies of the same is attached herewith for your information.

4. In view of the above it is requested to conduct an enquiry into the matter and take appropriate action as per the provision of law and forward a copy of the action taken report to the Board at the earliest.
