soon as possible. It is also brought to our notice that most of the States have their own Slaughtering Acts regulating slaughtering of animals.

The Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Ministry of Agriculture submits that the affidavit is necessary in the peculiar circumstances of the case before the Tribunal to vouch for authenticity of the minutes and will be filed within three days. No other State before us seeks time to file reply or any other material on record. We had granted time to the applicants and respondents to place their responses with relevant material in support of their cases and/or against rival cases. Time has expired. However, as regards the interim prayer, it will have to be considered on the material placed before us.
